# 18.110 PLANNING

- Council considered two applications, their comments forwarded to East Hampshire District Council:
- i) OBJECT Proposed David Fazakerley, Seconded Ian Hardy, Unanimously Resolved: 30021/066 Land at Lord Mayor Treloar Hospital Site, Chawton Park Road, Alton Reserved Matters application persuant to outline application 30021/056 – Development comprising 280 dwellings and a Country Park with access from Chawton Park Road with associated internal access roads, parking, landscaping, open space, footpaths and sustainable urban drainage (SuDS). (Appearance, landscaping, layout and scale to be considered)

Beech Parish Council has concerns regarding the proximity of the proposed dwellings to Ackender Woods, the amount of estate road which will create a large amount of hard standing and the increased traffic on the junction with the A339.

They would also request that the park land area includes the current wild flower habitat where wild orchids grow.

- ii) NO OBJECTION Proposed Ruth Duffin, Seconded David Fazakerley, Unanimously Resolved:
  - 25503/009 Marilea, 93 Medstead Road, Beech, Alton, GU34 4AE Detached dwelling after demolition of existing.

If the application is approved council would request a condition: Prior to construction commencing the Applicant shall submit a design, and obtain approval, for disposal of all surface water within the site. The submission should include calculations to BRE365 substantiating the design.

### 18.111 TRAFFIC CALMING

Council considered the proposed traffic calming measures which will cost £1,949.

- i) **Proposed David Fazakerley, Seconded Ruth Duffin, Unanimously Resolved:** For the Police to install speed camera signs, there is no cost to the Parish for this.
- Proposed Ruth Duffin, Seconded Ian Hardy, Unanimously Resolved: That a Public Consultation should be carried out regarding the proposed traffic calming measure. A flyer detailing the proposed measures will be delivered to every house and all the information will be posted on the Parish Council website and the Parish Council noticeboard.
- iii) Proposed David Fazakerley, Seconded Ian Hardy, Unanimously Resolved: The Clerk will get quotations for the printing of the flyer and Cllr David Woodroofe will draft the flyer to bring to the September meeting for Councils comments / approval.
- iv) Proposed David Fazakerley, Seconded Ian Hardy, Unanimoulsy Resolved: To request Hampshire Highways place the proposed measures on the work schedule, the works will be subject to the outcome of the Public Consultation.
