21.011 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES - RESOLVED

21.012 DECLARATION OF INTEREST

Councillor Ruth Duffin declared an interest in item 10. iii) planning application at Wyards Farm, Basingstoke Road, Alton.

21.013 ROAD SAFETY WORKING GROUP

Proposed Tony Ransley, Seconded Ruth Duffin, UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED to suspend Standing Orders so members of the Road Safety Working Group can speak.

The Road Safety Working Group Chairman, Sir Charles Cockburn, reported to the council on the updated report which will be submitted to Hampshire Highways. He also confirmed that Ian Janes from Hampshire Highways would act as sponsor and put the proposals before the Safety Audit team and this will not, certainly initially, incur any costs. A copy of the report/submission document is attached to the minutes, Appendix A, and can also be found on the Parish Council website.

Proposed Ruth Duffin, Seconded Alana Coombes, UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED to reinstate Standing Orders.

a) **Proposed Daniel Gordon, Seconded Ruth Duffin, RESOLVED** (Councillor Tony Ransley voted against) that the Parish Council accepts the latest draft of the report and authorises its release to Ian Janes and works with him to submit the report for a Safety Audit.

Proposed Ingrid McCormack, Seconded Alana Coombes, UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED to suspend Standing Orders so members of the Road Safety working Group can speak.

Council and members of the Road Safety Working Group discussed the possible purchase and use of an Automatic Number Plate Recognition speed camera which the working group had looked into as part of their report.
