December 2024 Beech Parish ASW Report

In Beech we are fortunate to have 3 AutoSpeedWatch Cameras monitoring traffic. The cameras give us invaluable intelligence about speeding traffic through our village.
Together with our 'Evocom' Speed Indicator Device we can monitor the effectiveness of the signage and identify the most frequent offenders.
Our Challenge is how to address these offenders and stop their anti-social behaviour. Despite our success in addressing the volume of offenses down 85% over the last 2 years, we continue to work diligently to address the issue of a few drivers who behave totally anti-socially by abusing the road through our village.
This report gives a monthly update of the intelligence we gather; data was significantly reduced as traffic volumes were minimal and weather conditions were very poor.

Actions this month:

- 1. We have received funding for 3 additional ASW cameras monitoring traffic from the A339 to Kings, and a New SID in the village centre.
- 2. We are continuing to engage with EHDC and the Police to get a firm plan on how to address the issue of signage and reporting going forward. Hampshire highways have stated that they and they alone are responsible for signage.
- 3. We are continuing to work to get HCC, the Police Commissioner, Hampshire Ambulance and Fire Services to re-instate the Hampshire Road Safety initiative. The Hampshire Association of Local Councils unanimously approved a motion offering their support for the Road Safety Partnership.
- 4. We are now reporting liveried vehicle incidents to the vehicle owners. In November the Clerk has written to 3 companies, 2 with 2nd letters to the owners. A further 3 have referred to the police.
- 5. The Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner have not arranged a promised follow up meeting. Tony Costigan is chasing.
- 6. We continue to support the ASW cameras in EHDC are rolling out. Lately engaging with Lasham.
- 7. We continue acting as part of the Bentworth CSW group. **But Hampshire Police has not given permission for the group to operate in Beech**.
- 8. We need to look at how our villagers can report near misses and generally poor anti-social driving behaviour easily. Awaiting details of proposals from the BRSW to add this facility to our web site.
- 9. The Beech Road Safety Working Group has in conjunction with Hampshire Highways including their road safety team completed works on an on-road footway see below:



1. Number of offenses by frequent speedsters Travelling NE through the village as a %age of total offenses.

The table below shows the number of offenses by number of vehicles over the last 12 months in Beech. So, **4** vehicles accounted for 5% of offenses, **518** offenses in total. They comprised **0.3** % of vehicles transversing the village. Just **284** vehicles accounted for half the speeding offenses over the last 12 months...



2. Number of vehicles.


Beech recorded 11435 vehicle incoming vehicles from SW @104 Medstead Rd between 1st and 31st^h of December 2024 well below the monthly average of fifteen and a half thousand a month. A total of 169,554 vehicles were recorded incoming in 2024.


@ 41 Medstead Road SW Direction




3. Percentile speeds NE direction (@104 Medstead Road)

Note the very small number who speed excessively ... less than 2%




4. Percentile speeds SW Direction (@ 41Medstead Road)





The maximum incoming speed recorded in 2024 mid village was **73** mph. and **76** mph outgoing in a 30mph limit. Average speeds year 2024 incoming was **25.45**, and **27.89** outgoing. The December equivalent figures we max 60mph and 76 mph, averages 25.31 and 27.04 mph.

Strangely enough to fast to qualify for a 20-mph zone, given Hampshire Highway criteria that for a 20-mph zone the average speed must be 24 mph or less??? However, we have satisfied that criterion by the Village Hall, and throughout the settlement policy boundary, see below.
